

EXCERPTS FROM THE BYLAWS

For vacant positions



5 – Council of Management (Officers, Duties and Powers)

- 5.1 The COM of the Association shall be elected from paid-up regular members and shall consist of three (3) officers and five (5) directors who together with the Immediate Past President shall be responsible for the management of the Association and shall have duties and powers as set out below:
- i. **Director 2 (Public Relations)** shall be responsible to:
Coordinate, develop, implement and manage plans for communication, public relations and marketing to promote and publicize the Association and its activities; and shall prepare and arrange communications and promotional materials and items in support of general and specific events; and shall maintain presence of the Association on the world wide web and social media.
 - ii. **Director 4 (Fundraising & Projects)** shall be responsible to:
Coordinate, develop, implement and manage plans for fund-raising events and other projects to achieve stated objectives of the Association.
 - iii. **Director 5 (Sports, Clubs & Culture)** shall be responsible to:
Coordinate, develop, implement and manage plans for cultural, sporting and other activities relating to culture, to achieve stated objectives.
- 5.3 Council of Management members may resign the office by giving one (1) month's notice in writing to the President.
- 5.4 Council of Management members will cease to be members of the COM where they:
- i. become incapable of managing the affairs of office by reason of injury or physical or mental illness;
 - ii. Are absent without reason from three (3) consecutive COM meetings and the COM, further to unanimous agreement, resolves that the office has been vacated;
 - iii. Fail to perform the responsibilities of their office as outlined heretofore;
 - iv. Notify the COM through the President of their wish to resign.
 - v. Are found guilty of any civil or criminal charge in a court of law;
- 5.5 Where legal charges – civil or criminal – are laid by any court on a member, that member shall take immediate leave of absence from the COM until the legal case is completed.
